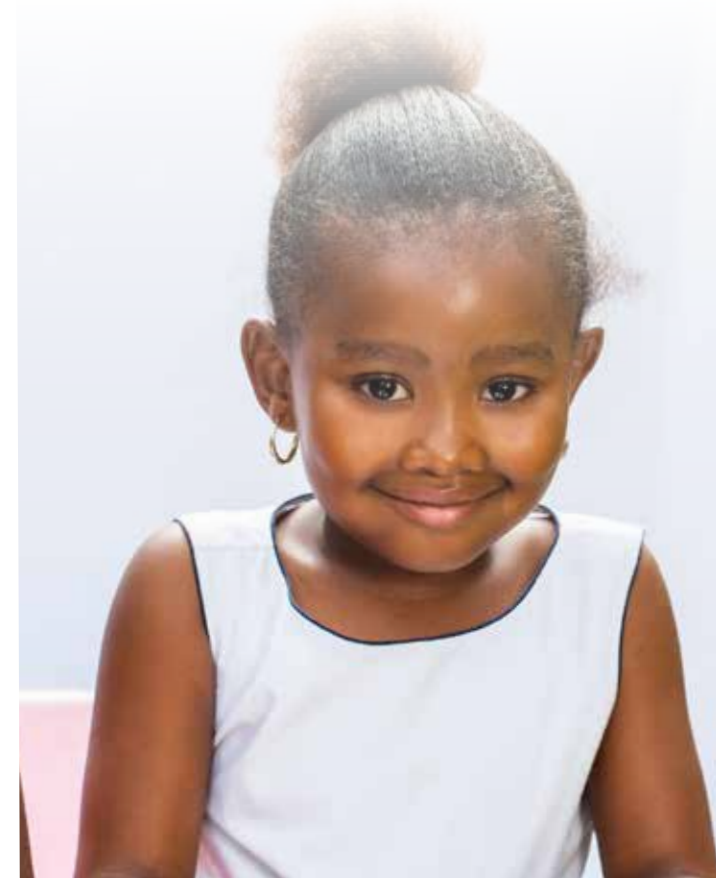

What is ECMHC?

ECMHC is a free service that supports young children's social and emotional development, specifically in early childhood education settings.

Early Childhood Mental Health Consultants are available to provide specialized on-site training and coaching at early learning programs which can ultimately reduce incidents of disruptive behavior and enhance social and emotional skills in children.


What Can Teaching Staff Expect?

- Individualized program and classroom specific consultation;
- Action plans that address classroom and individual child needs;
- Behavior management strategies for the whole class.

ECMHC Partnership

The Division of Prevention and Behavioral Health Services (DPBHS) offers ECMHC as a free service to Delaware early learning programs.

All consultants are licensed mental health professionals with experience working in early learning settings. ECMHC is a prevention and early intervention service. Request services before major problems arise. **Early Calls May Halt a Crisis.**

- Develop problem-solving interventions to reduce incidents of disruptive classroom behaviors;
- Build collaborative relationships between mental health professionals, early learning providers and families;
- Strengthen skills of teaching staff to work with children who have social and emotional challenges;
- Enhance relationships with children in care;
- Reduce teacher and family stress;
- Reduce incidents of suspension and expulsion; and
- Help children build social and emotional skills to reach developmental milestones.
