Policy 207 Reporting Professional Board Members

A. POLICY

A person reported to DFS for child abuse and neglect, and who is also licensed by one of the boards listed in [29 Del.C. § 8735](#), should be reported to the Division of Professional Regulation (DPR).

B. PROCEDURES

1. Reporting

2. DPR requests for information

When DPR contacts DFS to obtain DFS case information related to a report under DPR investigation, DFS should contact the DSCYF Deputy Attorney General (DAG) regarding the request. When the DSCYF DAG is unavailable, DFS should contact the Supervisor of the DFS DAGs.
